The Position:

This full time, seasonal, Galley Cook position would be a key member of our Guest Services staff on the Katahdin. The Cook is responsible for preparing and cooking the meals for the passengers and crew on cruising days and for several specially catered events. The cook will maintain quality in the galley and will coordinate with the Executive Director. Guest Services staff are key to providing exceptional customer service to our guests while preparing, serving food, and maintaining food safety and cleanliness standards.

Specific duties include:

- *Ability to represent Katahdin Cruises & Moosehead Marine Museum in a friendly and professional manner and to communicate effectively with guests, staff and volunteers.
- *Ability to perform a range of duties involved with preparing, cooking and serving foods
- *Ensures galley coverage for charters and evening Cruises as needed
- *Communicates with vendors for food and equipment supplies as needed
- *Handles guest complaints about food or service
- *Ensures Serv-Safe compliance by all galley staff
- *Accurately uses POS system and performs cash out duties when needed
- *Provides support to Deck hands on Ship as needed
- *Follows Katahdin emergency procedures if needed
